

Lecturer in Mathematics at Emory University Mathematics and Computer Science

The Department of Mathematics and Computer Science at Emory University invites applications for a position as Lecturer in Mathematics, to begin Fall 2014. Initial appointment is for a period of three years with renewals and promotions possible within the lecture-track as detailed in the Emory College of Arts and Sciences Guidelines for Appointment of Lecture-Track Faculty:

Responsibilities include:

1. teaching five semester courses per year;
2. supporting administration of the undergraduate program to include: advising undergraduates; coordinating the 100-level courses taught by graduate students; and, supervising and training graduate students as teachers;
3. participating in the life of the College through committees and other forms of academic service

Candidates must have a Ph.D. in mathematics or a related field, be excellent teachers and effective advisors, and have the potential to administer our undergraduate programs. Preference may be given to applicants who can contribute to our joint mathematics-economics major through teaching, advising, and curriculum development.
