## **Christine U. Lee, MD, PhD**

Consultant, Dept. of Radiology, Mayo Clinic, Rochester, MN

Associate Professor of Radiology, Mayo Clinic College of Medicine

Dr. Lee graduated with Highest Honors in Mathematics and Computer Science from Emory College in 1989, having held a 4-year Woodruff Scholarship. She was awarded a Marshall Scholarship (the first Emory woman to be so honored) and earned two MSc degrees from Oxford University in 1991. In 1999, Dr. Lee completed the 8-year PhD/MD program at the Mayo Graduate School and Mayo Graduate School of Medicine. She was a resident in internal medicine and radiology at the Mayo Clinic College of Medicine through 2004, held a radiology fellowship there through 2006, is currently Associate Professor of Radiology and is Consultant to the Mayo Clinic Department of Radiology. In 2017, Dr. Lee won the Mayo Graduate School of Medicine "Teacher of the Year" award, nominated and voted by the residents and trainees who study there.
